

RULE 5 - FIRST CLAIM STATUS - ALL RULES APPLY

FOREIGN ATHLETES JUNIOR/SENIOR MEN & WOMEN. Please note, not withstanding the above, athletes may NOT compete under these rules until they have been registered with UK Athletics, and have been resident in the UK for a minimum of two months prior to the date of competition.

RULE 207 (iv) (v) Junior Women who are aged 17, 18 or 19 on 31 August prior to the commencement of the competition year as defined above may take part in Road Relay competitions and compete in Senior events.

RULE 216(6) WILL APPLY

CLOTHING: <u>All</u> team runners <u>MUST</u> wear the same design of registered Club vest and colours, unless the Referee has given permission for a change to be made. Any advertising or sponsorship on clothing must comply with UK Athletics Rule 16.
